Normsa contacted Pearl Armstrong at HYA and together they decided that Normsa would need some literacy support as she had only been using English language for a short time. Normsa completed her Adult Literacy qualification and NVQ in a record 6 months due to her determination and hard work.

Normsa's manager has since promoted her to Senior Care Assistant because of her qualification and now Normsa has added responsibilities and duties to include administering medication, dealing with the doctors and district nurses and supervising staff.

Normsa is extremely pleased with HYA and wants to thank Pearl for helping her gain promotion and said that anyone would be able to complete this qualification if they had the help and support of HYA. Charles, Normsa's manager agrees with this and also wanted to comment on how much he thought of Normsa, explaining that she is a definite asset to the home and the service group that she looks after. Normsa is now looking at working towards a level 3 NVQ as she thoroughly enjoyed the last one.



In September 2007 the Humber Apprentice Panel (HAP) was formed, the panel has been made up of a diverse group of Apprentices from across the sub-region. Paula Kitching from HYA is currently on this panel, she is joined by 7 other Apprentices.

The panel gives Apprentices the chance to discuss their experiences as Apprentices and have their voices heard. It gives learners the opportunity to gain more confidence in discussing their futures and will help them to develop better communication & debating skills.



One of HAP's main objectives is to help Apprentices from across the Humber Sub-Region communicate with one and other, to help achieve this HAP have devised a forum for Apprentices to discuss all aspects of their Apprenticeship. HAP has also created a Facebook & Myspace account to compliment the forum.

Vice Chair of the regional learner panel is Dave Thompson from the Consortium for Learning. Dave has just been named as runner-up in the first annual VQ Hero awards in the Young Learner of the year category.



Dave completed his Business and Administration Advanced Apprenticeship in just ten months, well ahead of schedule and overcoming the frustration of having dyslexia. The success has inspired Dave to continue his development and is currently working towards his Customer Service Advanced Apprenticeship with HYA Training.

Dave was presented with his certificate on stage by Alesha Dixon at London's Royal Opera House in July 2008.
